TODAY'S GAME: The Biloxi Shuckers look to win their third game in a row and pull closer to first place on Wednesday at Pensacola...Jon Perrin gets the start for the Shuckers.

ORTIZ IMPRESSES IN OPENER WIN: Luis Ortiz tossed a career-high 7.0 innings as the Shuckers beat the Blue Wahoos 5-4 on Tuesday night...the righty allowed four hits and one run to earn his fourth win...Clint Coulter and Angel Ortega hit home runs...Jorge Lopez allowed three runs in the ninth but stranded the tying run at second to win the game.

WEEKLY WILKERSON: On the strength of his two-hit shutout on Sunday, Aaron Wilkerson was named Southern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday...he went 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA across two starts...the All-Star righty also received the award on May 21 for taking a no-hitter through 6.2 innings against the Braves...righty Corbin Burnes also took home the award on July 7.

PROSPECTING: MLB.com Pipeline released an updated Top 30 Prospects list this week, and four Shuckers appear on Milwaukee's radar...RHP Luis Ortiz is ranked #3, RHP Corbin Burnes is ranked #7, RHP Freddy Peralta is ranked #11, and C Jacob Nottingham is ranked #20.

JOHNNY BE GOOD: Shuckers outfielder Johnny Davis is the Southern League's active stolen base leader with 28 after teammate Mauricio Dubon (31 steals) was promoted to Triple-A Colorado Springs...he is tied for sixth in the league with five triples...he has collected a hit in 25 of his last 29 games...he went 4 for 5 with a three-run home run and a double on Sunday at Mississippi.

ANNYEONG, MICHAEL: Former Shuckers outfielder Michael Choice has joined the Korean Baseball Organization's Nexen Heroes after his contract was officially sold by the Brewers on Friday...the former Athletics and Rangers outfielder batted .272 with nine home runs and 29 RBI in 48 games since being signed by the Brewers on May 5...six of his home runs have come in the month of July, with three in one game on July 10 at Jacksonville...KBO teams are allowed up to three foreign players, one of whom must be a position player.

LOOKING AHEAD: The Shuckers officially announced their 2018 schedule on Monday...they open on the road at Montgomery for the second straight season before their home opener against Mississippi on April 11...they face the Mobile BayBears on July 3, one of 21 games against their closest geographic rival.

SHUCKERS IN THE BIGS: Former Shucker Garrett Cooper made his major league debut with the New York Yankees two weeks ago after being traded from the Brewers organization for LHP Tyler Webb on the final day of the All-Star break...he collected his first major league hit off David Price at Fenway Park...Cooper batted .299 with four home runs and 49 RBI with the Shuckers in 2016...RHP Jorge Lopez, RHP Brandon Woodruff, LHP Josh Hader and OF Brett Phillips have all received promotions to the Brewers since the end of May...there have been 14 former Shuckers to go on to the big leagues.

AGAINST THE WAHOOS: The Shuckers are 34-27 all-time against Pensacola, including 8-8 this season...they are 21-15 at Blue Wahoos Stadium.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: The Shuckers had six Southern League All-Stars this season, despite the cancellation of the game due to weather...Mauricio Dubon and Dustin DeMuth were selected as position players, and Angel Ventura, Aaron Wilkerson and Matt Ramsey were chosen to be part of the pitching staff...when Ventura was promoted to Triple-A, reliever Nick Ramirez took his place...the Shuckers had seven representatives in 2016 and a league-record 10 representatives in their inaugural 2015 season...Dubon also participated in the MLB Futures Game in Miami as a Team World representative.

vs. Pensacola: Perrin has made three appearances, two of them starts, against the Blue Wahoos this season...his last time facing them was on July 6, in which he took a tough-luck loss after allowing two runs in 5.0 innings.

2016: Walked one batter and struck out 47 in 36 innings with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers before being promoted to Brevard County on 5/11... Struck out a career-high 14 on 4/26 against Great Lakes in 6.2 innings... 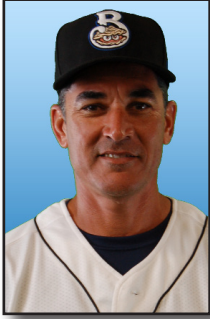

COACHING STAFF

MANAGER, MIKE GUERRERO



Guerrero begins his second season as Shuckers manager in 2017. Previously, he spent two seasons as the Brewers First Base Coach and Infield Coach, joining them in 2013.

Guerrero has managed at every level in the Minor Leagues, with all but one season coming with the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He last served as Manager for two seasons at Triple-A Nashville in 2012-13, prior to joining the Major League coaching staff.

In 2013, Guerrero earned the Mike Coolbaugh Award, presented to an individual who has shown an outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field.

Guerrero began his Managing career in the Blue Jays organization in 1995 in the Dominican Summer League. He won the 2001 Dominican Summer League championship and qualified for the playoffs five times (1995, 2000, 2001, 2007, 2009). He also gained additional Managerial experience in 2008 with the Oahu Canefires of the Hawaiian Winter League and in 2010 with the Surprise Rafters of the Arizona Fall League. He has also managed in the Dominican Winter League.

The former Minor League infielder spent nine seasons with the Milwaukee (1987-92, '94-95) and Kansas City (1993) organizations. He collected a .242 career batting average over nine seasons as a middle infielder.

Mike was born into a baseball family as Sandy and his father, Epy, was a renowned scout in the Dominican Republic who unearthed over 40 Major League players. Mike was named after former Major League pitcher Mike Torrez, who was a friend of his father. His uncle, Mario Guerrero, was a Major League infielder with Boston (1973-74), St. Louis (1975), California (1976-77) and Oakland (1978-80).

Mike and his wife Larissa reside in Melbourne, Fla and the couple has two sons, Michael and Daniel. Mike was born in Santo Domingo, DR.

COACH, SANDY GUERRERO



Guerrero, 51, enters his 15th season as a coach in the Brewers organization. Prior to joining the Shuckers in 2015, he coached at Double-A Huntsville (2003-08, 2014) and Triple-A Nashville (2009-11).

In addition, he spent two seasons as Hitting Coordinator from 2012-13. Guerrero served as Manager for the Northern Division in the 2007 Southern League All-Star Game after scheduled Manager Don Money pulled out of the contest to coach in the All-Star Futures Game. Before coaching, Guerrero had a 19-year playing career that included stints in the minors with Toronto and Milwaukee. He also played professionally in Mexico, Taiwan and the independent Northern League.
