TODAY'S GAME: The Fredericksburg Nationals return home for a six-game series against the Carolina Mudcats, Low-A East affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers, on Tuesday night.

LAST TIME OUT: The FredNats dropped their sixth game in a row on Sunday night, falling 10-2 to the Delmarva Shorebirds...Karlo Seijas lasted just 2.1 innings, allowing seven runs, six earned...the Shorebirds hit three home runs, taking a 2-0 lead on a Connor Norby blast in the first and capping off a five-run third with a three-run homer from Coby Mayo in the third...the FredNats did not score an earned run in the game, taking advantage of errors in the third and ninth to scratch across their only runs...Onix Vega hit an RBI single in the third to extend his hitting streak to a season-high 11 games.

MUDDY WATERS: The FredNats meet the Carolina Mudcats for the only time this season...they are 9-9 so far against the Central Division, with a series win at Down East, a split against Kannapolis, and a loss in Fayetteville...the FredNats and Mudcats have franchise history dating back to 2012, when the Mudcats joined the Carolina League...the P-Nats went 3-11 against the Mudcats in 2019.

WELCOME TO FREDERICKSBURG: The FredNats made a series of roster moves prior to Tuesday's game...joining the roster are three members of the 2021 Draft class: Infielder Darren Baker, left-handed pitcher Dustin Saenz, and right-handed pitcher Cole Quintanilla...Baker was a 10th round selection out of the University of California...Saenz was a fourth round selection out of Texas A&M...Quintanilla was a ninth round selection out of the University of Texas...all three played briefly in the Florida Complex League before joining the FredNats.

JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT: Infielder Junior Martina was promoted to Advanced-A Wilmington on Tuesday...Martina played in a team-leading 80 games for the FredNats, batting .269 with a team-high 81 hits...he hit three homers and drove in 36 runs, including the team's first walk-off hit on June 15.

INJURY REPORT: Catcher Geraldi Diaz was placed on the injured list on Tuesday...he had not played in a week prior to his status change.

RELEASES: Two members of the FredNats pitching staff were released on Tuesday...right-handed pitcher Trey Turner went 1-1 with a 5.40 earned run average in 13 relief appearances, striking out 21 batters in 18.1 innings...left-handed pitcher Christian Vann went 0-1 with a 39.00 earned run average in three appearances, totaling 3.0 innings.

BOOK YOUR FLIGHTS: The FredNats were already eliminated from postseason contention prior to Sunday's game in Delmarva, and were officially eliminated from the North Division race with their loss to the Shorebirds...they are now 24.0 games out behind first place Salem in the Northern Division with 24 games to play, becoming the third team in the league (Kannapolis, Augusta) to be eliminated from a division title.

SWEEP MEMORIES: The FredNats are mired in their third losing streak of six or more games, and their first since dropping six in a row June 24-30...last week's sweep at the hands of the Shorebirds was their first since losing 15 straight to start the season...they were swept in Lynchburg and at home against Delmarva.

LOW WATER MARK: With six straight losses, the FredNats are 30 games below .500...that marks the most games under .500 they've been this year.

DINGER DROUGHT: Onix Vega's two-run homer on Saturday was the first for the FredNats in 10 days, and the first since Kevin Strohschein took Chih-Jung Liu deep in the fifth inning of their August 11th game against Salem...that wass the longest streak of the season, surpassing a seven-game homerless drought from May 28-June 6...their seven homers in the month of August are tied with Kannapolis for the second-fewest among full-season minor league teams, ahead of only the Jupiter Hammerheads with five.

IN PAIN-YA: The FredNats activated infielder Viandel Peña from the injured list on Thursday and is 4-for-8 with a three doubles since his return...he suffered a lower body injury in Fredericksburg's game in Fayetteville on August 7, and was placed on the injured list on August 8.

THE NEW CLASS: Last Tuesday marked the professional debuts of Branden Boissiere, Jaden Fein and Jacob Young, all members of the 2021 Draft class...so far, they are a combined 6-for-56...Fein collected his first hit on Wednesday, and Boissiere and Young got theirs on Friday... they became the first members of the 2021 class to arrive in Fredericksburg...Boissiere was a third round selection out of Arizona, where he played first base and outfield...Fein was a 15th round selection out of San Diego State...Young was a seventh round selection out of Florida.

IN THE PIPELINE: Now that the trade deadline has passed and the 2021 Draft class has signed, MLB Pipeline has updated its top 30 prospects in the Nationals organization...current FredNats include RHP Jackson Rutledge (#5), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (#13), 1B Branden Boissiere (#21) and SS Jordy Barley (#29)...former FredNats include LHP Mitchell Parker (#19), SS Jackson Cluff (#23) and LHP Seth Romero (#28).

THANKS FOR THE MEMORIES: Two of the most productive members of the 2021 FredNats offense received promotions to Advanced-A Wilmington last Tuesday...outfielder Ricardo Méndez, who led the team in batting average at .289, joined the Blue Rocks...so did Kevin Strohschein, who led the team with 11 home runs...Méndez's 19-game hitting streak from June 30 to July 22 was the longest for the FredNats this season...Strohschein hit the club's first grand slam, walk-off homer and inside-the-park homer.

TONIGHT'S START: Michael Cuevas makes his 13th start of 2021, and his 16th overall appearance, in the opener against Carolina.

LAST TIME OUT: Cuevas had trouble with his command last Wednesday at Delmarva, issuing a career-high four walks in a 3-1 loss to the Shorebirds...he allowed only one run on a bases-loaded walk to Connor Pavolony in the fourth, and left with one out in the fifth trailing 1-0.

AGAINST THE MUDCATS: Cuevas has never faced Carolina.

CUEVAS INTERRUPTUS: Cuevas saw his start against Kannapolis on July 8 shortened due to a suspension due to rain in the middle of the second...the game was resumed the next day with the Cannon Ballers winning 14-2, handing Cuevas the loss...since then, he has pitched into the fifth inning in every start.

IN THE INFIRMARY: Cuevas made one appearance on May 5 before being placed on the injured list on May 8...he was activated on June 2.

PRE-PANDEMIC: Cuevas went 1-0 with a 0.59 ERA over 15.1 innings with the GCL Nationals in 2019, his first professional season...he struck out 9 batters and walked 8 in 8 appearances, 7 in relief...he earned one save...lefties batted .333 against him, while righties were held to a .158 average.

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Full name: Michael Tyler Cuevas...selected in the 23rd round of the 2019 Draft out of Brennan (TX) HS, where he pitched and played shortstop...favorite movie is Moneyball...favorite television show is Avatar: The Legend of Korra...favorite player growing up was Tim Lincecum...got really good at Guitar Hero during the pandemic... favorite pregame meal is Wild Berry Skittles...is good at drawing.

YOUNG GUN: At 19 years old, Cuevas was the youngest player on the inaugural FredNats Opening Day roster...he turned 20 on June 29...Jeremy De La Rosa, who joined the club on May 14, was born in January of 2002 and is six months younger.

IN THE BALLPARK: When Cuevas allowed a solo home run to Salem's Jaxx Groshans on June 9, he told teammates that it was the first home run he had ever remembered serving up in his life...he has now allowed six this season.
